All dues are typically due by 8/20 for Fall semester and 1/20 for Spring semester.

Financial Aid Plan: 100% of dues paid by 9/20 for Fall semester or 2/20 for Spring semester. This is typically used for members who are waiting for financial aid to come.

Three-Month Plan: 34% of dues paid by 8/20, 33% paid by 9/20, 33% due by 10/20 for Fall. 34% paid by 1/20, 33% paid by 2/20, 33% paid by 3/20. This is typically used for members who can't pay everything all at once and want to spread it out.
